# Finding a Fit



- •A Fit is 8+ cards in one suit
- •If there is a fit in a major this will be the trump suit
- •If there is no fit, then choose NoTrumps





## Levels of Bidding

- The number of tricks you must make to get a score = 6 + the level you bid
  - 1-level contracts ... Must make 7 tricks (6 + 1)
  - 2-level contracts ... Must make 8 tricks (6 + 2)
  - 3-level Contracts ... Must make tricks (6 + 3) etc
  - 4-level Contracts ... Must make

• 6-level Contracts ... Must make





### The Auction

- Every suit has a ranking order
- Each bid must be higher than the previous bid

1*	1 ♦	1♥	1 🛧	1NT
2 🚓	2 ♦	2♥	2 🌲	2NT
3♣	3 ♦	3♥	3♠	3NT
4*	4 •	4♥	4 🛦	4NT
		etc		

- The first person to bid is the Opener
- Opener's partner is the Responder




## **Basic Rules for Opening I-suit**

You must have enough High Card Points







# **Opener's First Bid**

	Points	Description
1NT	15 – 17	Balanced hand SPECIAL CASE
14	12 – 19	5 + spades
1 💙	12 – 19	5 + hearts
1 •	12 – 19	3 + diamonds
14	12 - 19	3 + clubs



### Opening Bid Rules – 12-19 HCP

The order in which you bid your suits is very important. Here are the rules:

- INT if 15-17 HCP and balanced (Special Case)
- Longest suit first

   (unless it's a minor and you have a 5-card major)
- Higher ranking 5-card suit (so spades before hearts if equal length)
- •Preferred minor (ID if 4-4 in the minors, IC if 3-3 in the minors)



### Rules for 1-level suit openings

Bid your **longest** suit first

Bid your higher ranking 5-card suit first





# Basic Rules for I-level suit openings Bid your PREFERRED MINOR first







# What do you open with this hand?



# Open I &

... no 5-card major, open your preferred minor



### What do you open with this hand?



# Open I &

... open your higher ranking 5-card suit first



## **Further Bidding**

#### ... To come in more detail

- Responder needs 6 + points to bid ... At least 1/2 of what Opener needs
- Try to find a Fit as soon as possible
- There are 3 choices of level to bid to:
  - 1. Minimum (6-9)
  - 2. Close to Game (10 12)
  - 3. Enough for Game (13+)
- If there is NO fit, then bid NoTrumps
- To bid Game you need 25+ points between the two hands





- INT if 15-17 HCP and balanced (Special Case)
- Longest suit first

- Higher ranking 5-card suit
   (so spades before hearts if equal length)
- •Preferred minor (ID if 4-4 in the minors, IC if 3-3 in the minors)


